There is plenty of time to snorkel and the surrounding reef is alive with local marine life including starfish, lobsters, colorful fish, sea turtles and rays of course. *Location: Antigua. Paddlers make waves in the crystal waters of The Bahamas' Moriah Marine Park when they **Kayak in Paradise**. Experienced guides describe the local ecology of these calm waters and show off conch, snapper and yellowtail in coral colonies. As the route meanders through mangrove creeks, kids can play Exuma's version of the "license plate game" being the first to spot rays and turtles on the sandy sea floor or oystercatchers and osprey in the sky. And of course there's a stop for swimming and snorkeling

Families setting sail on the **Underwater Submarine Adventure** will be thrilled by the unforgettable 360-degree view of Providenciales' spectacular and vibrant sea life. Guests stay dry and in air-conditioned comfort on this glass bottom semi-sub, while kids can channel their inner Jacques Cousteau and marvel at brilliantly-colored fish, stingrays, sea turtles and wow-inspiring coral formations in the pristine waters of the Turks & Caicos Islands. *Location: Providenciales, the Turks & Caicos Islands. Rates: \$59.00 (ages 12 and over); \$49.00 (ages 1-11).*

On the **Dolphin Touch** excursion, an up-close experience with these bottlenose beauties takes "handson learning" to a whole new level. Parents and kids learn all about these intelligent and curious mammals, while the knee-deep water platform is a perfect height to get nose-to-nose for a gentle touch. Parents beware: Kids might ask, "Can we keep it?" *Location: Jamaica. Rates: starting at \$86.00 (ages 12 and over); \$77.00 for children (ages 5-11).*
